- 1/17 First day for filing an application for place on the ballot
- 2/16 5:00 p.m. Deadline for filing an application for a place on the ballot** (*The City Secretary's office is allotted five days to review applications (Texas Election Code [§141.032(a)]); If your application is found to be invalid or incomplete after the filing deadline has passed, you cannot re-file; Therefore, it is suggested that you file your application at least one week before this deadline*)
- 2/22 Drawing to determine order of names on the ballot at 4:30 p.m. in the City Secretary's office (405 Municipal Dr.)** (*Candidates and/or their representatives are encouraged (but not required) to be present for the drawing*)
- 2/23 5:00 p.m. Last day for a candidate to withdraw (Must receive in writing, see pp. 285-286)
- 4/5 **CAMPAIGN FINANCE***: First report of campaign contributions and expenditures (pp. 199-214) due by 5:00 p.m. in the City Secretary's office; or by midnight, if filed electronically (citysecretary@cityofkennedale.com)
Last day a person may register to vote in the upcoming General Election
- 4/23 First day for early voting by personal appearance
- 4/23 to 5/1 Polls are open for early voting by personal appearance at the Kennedale Community Center (inside the Library at 316 W 3rd St.); Hours vary; Visit www.cityofkennedale.com/election for details, including voting hours
- 4/27 **CAMPAIGN FINANCE***: Second report of campaign contributions and expenditures (pp. 199-214) due by 5:00 p.m. in the City Secretary's office; or by midnight, if filed electronically (citysecretary@cityofkennedale.com)
- 5/5 ELECTION DAY: Polls open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Community Center in the Library (316 W 3rd St.)**
- 5/16 Last day for official canvass of returns by governing authority of political subdivision
Winners declared and sworn into office for two-year terms (*unless a runoff election is necessary*)

**Must be filed even if there is no activity to report for the period covered; Required of all opposed candidates and specific purpose committees supporting or opposing opposed candidates, unless they filed under "Modified Reporting" and have not, as of the deadline, exceeded the \$500.00 threshold for donations or expenditures; Candidates/Officeholders do not have to file if they chose "Modified Reporting" on page 2 of form CTA (p. 71) and neither accept more than \$500.00 in political/campaign-related contributions or make more than \$500.00 in political/campaign-related expenditures during the period covered by the report; See page 3 for more information*
